FAQs: January intake

1. Which courses are available to study from January 2025?

The BEng (Hons) and MEng (Hons) [Global Design Engineering](#) degrees are both open to applications for the January 2025 start date.

These are both 'undergraduate courses'. The MEng (Hons) is an integrated masters course. You can apply here now: <https://tedi-london.ac.uk/apply/direct-application-to-tedi-london/>

The deadline to apply is **Friday 13th December**.

2. What are the course start dates for Year 1?

You will need to be in attendance from **9th January 2025**, teaching will begin on 13th January 2025.

3. What will my schedule look like and how are the credits distributed?

The first year of your course will be intensive you'll be studying 60 credits in your first block, which will be very demanding on your time. You'll also complete a summer school in July of your first year.

Block 1 - 60 credits (condensed)

Block 2 - 40 credits

Summer school - 20 credits

Once you have completed the above, your subsequent years (year 2 onwards) will be scheduled from September to June / July each year, as per the September cohort.

4. How much time will I need to devote to my studies?

Your first teaching block will be intensive. You'll be completing 60 credits, which means you should commit fully to study only in block 1, rather than try to combine study with significant working hours.

10 credits = c.100 hours of study.

5. Is Student Finance available to help pay for my fees and maintenance?

Yes – eligible students will be able to apply for Student Finance to fund this course. Please check your individual eligibility directly with [Student Finance](#).

6. What other financial help does TEDI-London offer?

TEDI-London is pleased to be able to offer a range of [Scholarships and Bursaries](#).

Our International Scholarships and Participation Scholarships will be available to apply for during the admissions process.

7. I am an international student who would need a visa to study, am I able to take this course?

Yes, you'll be eligible to apply for this course. The process to apply for the January start date is the same as the September intake. [Student visa : Overview - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#)

8. Am I eligible for all of the same benefits and opportunities as full time TEDI-London students?

Yes – you will be fully integrated into the TEDI-London student community with opportunities to attend and support our events, use the same facilities and work with the same faculty members.

You'll also be eligible for various student discounts available through the likes of Unidays and Totum.

9. Will you be running the Maths Refresher?

Yes, we'll run the Maths Refresher for the January 2025 start. Applicants who need to take the Maths Refresher must pass the course by 10th December to meet their conditions for that intake. If applicants do not pass the course in time for the January 2025 start date, we may need to switch you to the September 2025 start date.

10. Will I need to complete an interview as part of the admissions process?

UK/Home students – you may need to complete an interview depending on your education or work background. The admissions team will advise if this is required during the application process.

International students – all students who need visa sponsorship from TEDI-London will be required to complete an interview. We'll arrange this at a mutually convenient time, accommodating your time zone where possible.
